

KEY RESIN #553 100% SOLIDS EPOXY BLOCK FILLER

DESCRIPTION

KEY RESIN #553 is a two component, 100% solids high build epoxy block filler specially formulated to fill and level porous masonry block (CMU) surfaces and imperfections in poured concrete substrates. **KEY RESIN #553** will fill most small voids and crevices to provide a smooth, even surface for coating. Ideal for interior and exterior use, **KEY RESIN #553**, with the appropriate seal coats, provides a system with excellent chemical and abrasion resistance while maintaining a cleanable wall surface.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Substrate must be above 50°F and relative humidity below 85% for proper curing.
- Substrate must be free of dirt, waxes, curing agents, and other foreign materials.

COMPOSITION

Modified polyamide epoxy resin and fillers.

CLEAN-UP

Clean tools with xylene, lacquer thinner, or hot soapy water.

APPLICATION

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface Preparation is the most critical portion of any successful resinous flooring system application. All substrates must be properly prepared as outlined in KEY RESIN COMPANY'S TECHNICAL BULLETIN #1. Work must be performed by trained or experienced contractors or maintenance personnel. KEY RESIN COMPANY Technical Service is pleased to answer any questions.

INSTALLATION

Mix **KEY #553** for 3-4 minutes in the proper mixing ratio, (2 parts Part A-Resin to 1 part Part B-Hardener, by volume). Proper mixing is confirmed when resin is a consistent color with no streaks. Only mix what can be used in 20-25 minutes at 75°F. **KEY RESIN #553** will have a paste consistency.

Apply **KEY RESIN #553** with a trowel or putty knife at a coverage rate of 75-160 ft² per gallon or as needed to fill voids. Two coats will be necessary to fill/level CMU grout joints. CMU joints should first be filled and striked off flush (allow to cure hard) before skim coating entire block wall surface. Trowel marks should be sanded smooth before topcoating.

RECOAT

At 75°F, **KEY RESIN #553** is tack free in 6-8 hours and can be re-coated or topcoated in 10-12 hours.
